Got Customers?

Home Loan State Bank wants to inform you about a rise in email scams targeting business clients. Fraudsters are hacking third-party vendor accounts and sending deceptive emails to reroute payment information to their own accounts. To protect yourself, consider the following tips:

- Verify payment changes: If you receive an email requesting a change in payment details, always confirm its legitimacy directly with your customer. Use the contact information you have on file, rather than relying on details in the email itself, for an extra layer of protection.
- Examine suspicious emails closely: Look out for grammatical mistakes, inconsistencies, or incorrect information within the email. These scams are often hurriedly created and can contain telltale errors.
- Rely on our safeguards:
 Home Loan State Bank has robust systems in place to monitor ACH payment changes. If a modification seems suspicious, our team will contact you to ensure its validity.

Follow the instructions to take a photo of the front and back of the check.
